Input Expos

Framework Open Houses and Discussion Forums will be held in each county in April. The purpose of the events is to 1) provide information on housing, transportation, and land use to local governments and the general public; 2) provide information on the Framework project; 3) obtain input and develop strategies around housing, transportation, energy, and land use. Public input will be obtained via surveys, comment cards, a visual preference survey, and discussion tables. The vents will feature:

- **Surveys.** Housing and transportation surveys will be available at the registration tables and at the topic tables within the event space.
- **Tables/displays.** Posters, comment cards, maps, brochures, and other materials will be available at each table. Topic tables will include:

 - Rental Housing
 - Rail/Air
 - Ownership Housing
 - Roads/Highways
 - Energy efficiency/conservation

- **Discussion Tables.** Participants will be able to join or begin a conversation with other attendees. Facilitators will take notes, moderate, and provide information as necessary.
- **Presentations.** Short Powerpoint presentations with recorded voice-over will play periodically. Presentations on housing, transportation, and land use will include a summary of findings to date and information to aid in developing strategies.
- **Computer Station.** Participants may use the computer station to complete surveys online, use the project website, and/or post about the event on social media.
- **Childcare.** Licensed day care will be provided. Activities and input opportunities for children/teenagers will be available.
- **Visual preference survey.** A visual preference survey will allow participants to select from hard copy/digital photos of development examples for future development/redevelopment in the county's Growth and Investment areas.
